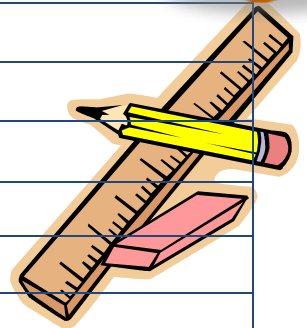
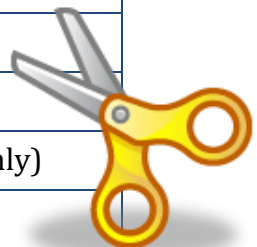
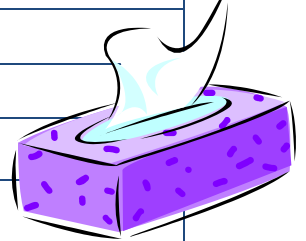

3rd - 4th Grade Class Supply List

Welcome to Grace Christian Academy! The supplies are pretty basic and practical (based on experience and what works best). Please make sure your child has the following supplies on the first day:

1	Plastic two-pocket folder with NO 3-prong for communication folder
1	"Post-it" flags / place marker pack
2	"Post-it" notes (2x2")
1	Bottle of Elmer's Glue
1	Book bag or backpack
2	Glue sticks
2	Dozen "Dixon Ticonderoga" brand pencils (please sharpen)
1	"Magic Rub Sanford" <u>WHITE Eraser</u> or "Pentel Hi-Polmer" <u>White Eraser</u>
1	Set -Twistable colored pencils or roll-up crayons
4	Papermate "clear point" mechanical pencil with extra lead and erasers (0.5mm lead only)
1	Student scissors "Fiskars" (larger sized)
2	100-Sheet package College-ruled binder paper
1	1" 3-Ring binder for writing binders (new students only)
8	Plastic binder dividers with tabs and pockets for writing binders (new students only)
1	Package of 3x5" lined index cards
3	Ball-point pens - blue, green, or purple
1	Easy to open small plastic pencil box (a cigar box style)
1	Bag of cough drops
2	Highlighters, any color
1	Pack of dry erase markers
1	Large box tissues
PE	Small gym bag with the following: good athletic shoes, navy or black knee-length athletic shorts and or warm-up pants, GCA logo PE shirt (available by order in school office), sun-glasses, visor or hat.



Water bottles and a small snack are fine to send with your child. The snack should be something that can be eaten in about 5 minutes, finger food size, and non-messy.
